Structure Fire

Captain/CO	Safety Don SCBA Scene size-up, report and resource location Establish Command Perform 360/TIC Gather information to develop strategy and tactics Radio, tool and light
Engineer	Spot engine Don SCBA Establish water source Provide water to fire attack Pull secondary pre-connect (RIC) Provide scene lighting Provide a staging area for tools and equipment Radio, tool and light
FF Position 3	Don SCBA Radio, tool and light Pull fire attack pre-connect to point of entry Ensure all PPE is in place Confine fire aggressively but provide for safety first
FF Position 5	Don SCBA Radio, tool and light Back-up FF on attack line Acquire tools for forcible entry Extinguisher if needed/Honda light if needed Make hydrant connection Follow direction from Captain/CO

Vehicle Fire

Captain/CO	Safety Scene size-up, report and resource location/Threat to wildland Establish Command Don SCBA Gather information to develop strategy and tactics Back up FF's on attack line if needed
Engineer	Spot engine Set pump and charge fire attack line Traffic control Provide scene lighting
FF Position 3	Don SCBA Radio, tool and light Pull pre-connect for fire attack Aggressively extinguish fire safely
FF Position 5	Don SCBA Radio, tool and light Secure and stabilize vehicle Irons/Circ. Saw to vehicle Back up FF with fire attack

Vegetation Fire

Captain/CO	Safety Scene size-up and resource location Gather information to develop strategy and tactics Don hose pack Hand tool
Engineer	Spot engine Set up safety line for engine/safety zone Supply water to fire attack Assist with the first 300' of the hose-lay
FF Position 3	Don hose pack Stretch hose line for progressive hose-lay Establish an anchor point Lead Firefighter on hose-lay
FF Position 5	Don hose pack Assist with deployment of hose-lay Back up FF Hand tool

Vehicle T/C and Extrication

Captain/CO	Safety Scene size-up and resource location Establish Command Gather information to develop strategy and tactics
Engineer	Spot Engine/Rescue Provide scene lighting if necessary Provide safety line or extinguisher as indicated by Captain/CO Provide tool staging area Traffic control/cone/flare off work zone Assist with Patient care
FF Position 3	Bring hydro unit to a central location with tools Utilize tools for patient extrication Patient care and assessment
FF Position 5	Stabilize vehicle Assist with tool set up Prep patient for extrication operation Back up FF with extrication operations Patient care and assessment Follow direction from Captain/CO or Medics at scene

Haz-Mat

Captain/CO	Safety Scene size-up and resource location (Staging area) Gather information to develop strategy and tactics (SIN) Request a second tone out for BS7145 Request County Haz-Mat team
Engineer	Spot engine (Up-hill, Up wind and Up-stream) Engage pump if necessary Traffic control Assist FF's with isolate and deny entry
FF Position 3&5	Follow the direction of the Captain/ CO with isolate and deny entry Don SCBA and assist with evacuation to safe area if appropriate

Residential Alarm

Captain/CO	Safety Scene size-up and resource location Don SCBA Radio, TIC, tool and light Establish Command/Investigate
Engineer	Spot engine, give the Captain/ CO a view of three sides Scene lighting if needed Follow direction from Captain/ CO
FF Position 3	Don SCBA Radio, tool and light Extinguisher/Water can Follow direction from Captain/ CO
FF Position 5	Don SCBA Radio, tool and light Irons Follow direction from Captain/ CO

Commercial Alarm

Captain/CO	Safety Don SCBA Radio, TIC, tool and light Scene size-up/Investigate Establish Command/Tac channel Resource location (Staging area) Request Truck Company if necessary Pre-plan binder Knox Box keys
Engineer	Spot engine (FDC/Level I staging) Scene lighting if needed Follow direction from Captain/CO
FF Position 3	Don SCBA Radio, tool and light Extinguisher/Water can Follow direction from Captain/CO
FF Position 5	Don SCBA Radio, tool and light Irons Follow the direction from Captain/CO

Multi Casualty

Captain/CO	Safety Scene size-up and resource location (Staging) Established Command/Advised dispatch of the MCI Request additional resources (BS7145 if not already en-route)
Engineer	Spot engine Treatment unit leader Patient recording (Information) Transfer patient to Transport Unit Leader
FF Position 3	Triage Unit Leader Begin and direct resources for Triage Assist in movement of patients Re-assess if needed Follow direction from Captain/CO
FF Position 5	Assist with Triage/Treatment Follow direction from Captain/CO
