



## **Performance Standard**

**TOPIC:** FIRE SHELTER DEPLOYMENT

**TIME FRAME:** :45

**LEVEL OF COMPLEXITY:** Level 1

**BEHAVIORAL OBJECTIVE:**

**Condition:** Given a training fire shelter and full wildland PPE

**Behavior:** Fire personnel will deploy the shelter with a simulated fire front approaching

**Standard:** 100% accuracy within 45 seconds

**PERFORMANCE:**

**Time starts when proctor states direction of fire front and need for shelter deployment:**

(Firefighter will start with full wildland PPE donned)

- Leaving web gear on
- Obtain shelter
- Deploy the shelter in an adequate deployment area with head facing away from the fire front
- Secure shelter tightly to ensure proper seal

**Time stops when proctor ensures shelter is secure**

**NOTES:**

\*\*\*Automatic Fail\*\*\*

- Facing toward the oncoming flame front
- Any portion of firefighter visible from outside
- Shelter not properly secured
- If participant is unable to complete standard within the time allotted

*Performance standards are designed to assure that all fire personnel are capable of completing the duties assigned to their respective position. All personnel should remember that while engaging in firefighting operations, the order and/or priority of some tasks may be changed by the company officer.*
