



## Performance Standard

**TOPIC:** PRIMARY SEARCH AND RESCUE (RESIDENTIAL)

**TIME FRAME:** 5:00

**LEVEL OF COMPLEXITY:** Level 1

**BEHAVIORAL OBJECTIVE:**

**Condition:** Given full structure PPE with SCBA and axe belt, blacked out face piece, and a firefighter for search assistance

**Behavior:** Fire personnel will search the structure for a victim and remove the victim from the structure

**Standard:** 100% accuracy within 5 minutes

**PERFORMANCE:**

**Time starts when fire personnel enter the doorway**

- Enter the structure on hands and knees
- Begin search using a wall as a reference (determined by crew)
- Find and obtain victim (rescue dummy)
- Remove victim from the structure

**Time stops when fire personnel exit the front door with victim**

**NOTES:**

\*\*\*Structure type and Victim requirements\*\*\*

- Structure Size: Less than 1500 Sq Ft, 2-4 bedrooms
- Position victim approximately 30' travel distance from door

\*\*\*Automatic Fail\*\*\*

- If participants are unable to complete standard within the time allotted

*Performance standards are designed to assure that all fire personnel are capable of completing the duties assigned to their respective position. All personnel should remember that while engaging in firefighting operations, the order and/or priority of some tasks may be changed by the company officer.*
